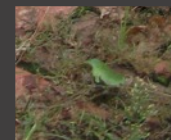
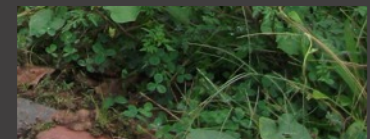
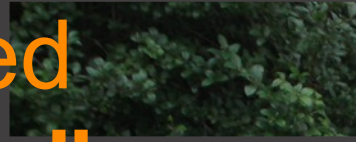
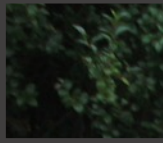


Abandoned “nuisance” property at 301 North Second Street



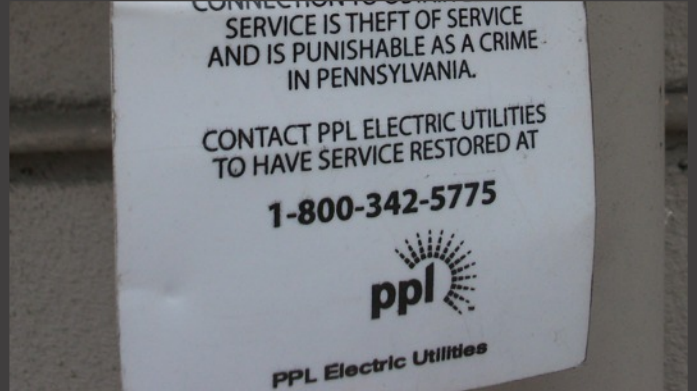
Overgrown weeds and bushes control pavement.

Note the discontinuance of electric service tag on the meter.

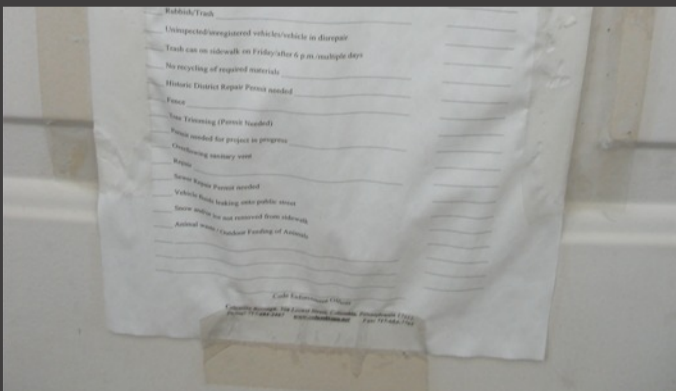
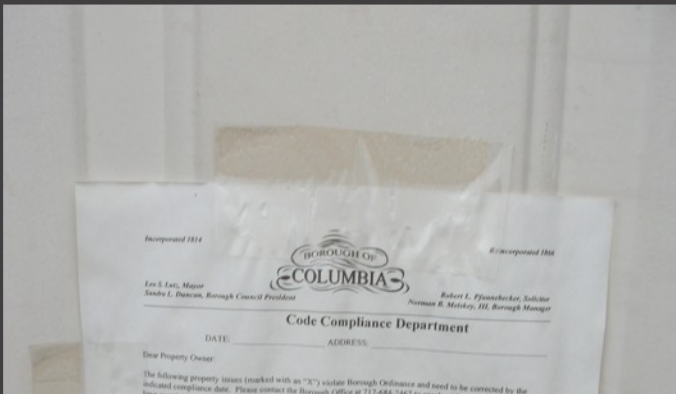
It may be a sign of the tough times, but shouldn't the Borough get rid of the weeds and charge the property owner?
