

## RESTAURANT INSPECTIONS

The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, 866-366-3723, uses a "risk-based" inspection reporting process for restaurants and other food handlers.

The following inspection reports were completed Sept. 13-19.

**88 Chinese Express**, 31 N. Queen St., Sept. 16. Complaint-based inspection is founded. Larvae found on food served to the public. It was determined that the produce was not washed sufficiently enough to uncover larvae. Broccoli was cooked and larvae emerged. Broccoli and all other produce is to be triple washed and inspected prior to cooking.

**Character's Pub**, 38 N. Christian St., Sept. 16. New menus being printed to reflect the consumer advisory. Provide paper towels at hand sink and maintain. Corrected.

**Charley's Grilled Subs**, 142 Park City Center, Sept. 16. No violations.

**Denny's No. 1906**, 2204 Columbia Ave., Sept. 16. Food

employee put on single-use gloves without a hand wash. Corrected. Food employees returning to work from break without washing hands before resuming work. Corrected. A food employee touched celery stalks, a ready-to-eat food, with bare hands. Corrected. Employees stuck fingers inside small creamer cups and inside small syrup cups. Corrected. Oil drips on the fire

suppression line running over the fryer area. Possible contamination from dripping into prepped food. Loose caulking over the fryer area. Dirty utensils hanging on magnetic strip for clean utensils. All utensils in the utensil drawer are not clean. Clean entire drawer and utensils. Many dirty pots and pans stored. Clean all utensils and pots and pans before using. Dishwasher in the food prep area had an accumulation of dust, dirt, food residue and debris on non-food contact surfaces. Food residue and grease on the stainless steel walls at the fryer area.

**Dollar General No. 2203**, 553 W. Main St., Mount Joy, Sept. 13. Slide main door at receiving area is not tight.

**Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre**, 510 Centerville Road, Sept. 13. Bulk food ingredient storage containers in the food prep area are not labeled with

the common name of the food. Corrected. Deeply scored cutting boards for salad prep not resurfaced or discarded as required. Large mixer in the food prep area had an accumulation of food residue and debris on nonfood contact surfaces. Corrected. Clean dish racks stored on the floor. Corrected. Outside waste handling unit had drain plug removed.

**East Petersburg Elementary School**, 5700 Lemon St., East Petersburg, Sept. 14. No violations.

**Gingrich's Food Market**, 216 W. Hill St., Bainbridge, Sept. 14. Repacked items produced at facility are not labeled to identify ingredient contents. Walk-in cooler floor is constructed of wood and has damage, making the areas not smooth and easily cleanable. Ceiling tiles are damaged in retail area. Dock doors are not sealed tightly at the bottom.

**Hans Herr Elementary School**, Lampeter, Sept. 13. No violations.

**Haydn Zug's**, 1987 State St., East Petersburg, Sept. 15. Raw chicken was stored above raw beef in the walk-in cooler. Corrected. Raw eggs stored over top of ready-to-eat foods. Corrected. Condensation dripping inside the reach-in cooler.

Foods were covered and moved to the back of the unit. Corrected. Heavy accumulation of black residue and grease on exhaust baffles over fryer. Old food residue buildup on ladies. Corrected. Static dust on ceiling and light fixtures over food prep area. Corrected. No sign posted at the hand sink in the food prep area and the women's restroom to remind food employees to wash their hands. Corrected.

Food facility does not have available sanitizer test strips or test kit to determine appropriate sanitizer concentration. Replace rubber gasket on ice machine and maintain.

**Ridge Run Tavern**, 4620 Ridge Road, Elizabethtown, Sept. 15. Ice machine has residue accumulations on the deflector shield. Food facility is using an approved non-public water system, but does not have current laboratory testing results for water potability. The food facility does not employ a certified employee as required.

**River Street Cafe**, 38-40 E. Front St., Marietta, Sept. 14. No violations.

**Rocky Springs Entertainment Center**, 1495 Millport Road, Sept. 13. No violations.

**Salad Works**, 142 Park City Center, Sept. 16. No violations.

**Target No. 2545**, 960 Littitz Pike, Littitz, Sept. 15. Light visible under two doors in warehouse. Seal to prevent vector entrance.
