## Mt. Joy personnel costs too high

On Dec. 5, correspondent K. Scott Kreider wrote an article about the public support for the Mount Joy Police Department. His subheadline was, "Speakers urge council members to oppose cuts in the \$1.3M budget."

While the borough's online budget indicates that the public safety budget is approximately \$1.3M, this portion of the budget does not include any of the employee benefits for the department as they are found in another portion of the budget under employee benefits.

The total for all benefits for borough employees is \$1,015,405. Based on the borough website, the police department makes up 50 percent of the borough's full-time employees. Therefore, you must add \$500,000 to the police budget.

The department budget is really \$1.8M. Using Kreider's figure of 13 full-time employees, it cost

borough residents an average of \$138,000 to put each full-time police person on the street.

This is not about the competence of the members of the department but about the ability of the taxpayer to sustain these costs.

The reduction of one full-time officer would reduce the current projected budget deficit by 25 percent.

Unless the department makes some concessions on wages and/or benefits, it would seem the borough council doesn't have many options.
