As a customer of Columbia Water Company, you were notified on March 14, 2013 of a problem with our drinking water due to a break-in that occurred at one of our storage tank/pumping station locations during the overnight hours of March 13th. You were advised to not consume your drinking water as a precaution.

We are pleased to report that the testing has been completed and that your drinking water is now safe to drink and use for all purposes. The do not consume advisory is no longer in place. The DEP test results indicated that no contamination occurred.
