

# Bogeys and Birdies Drive Donations

*Turkey Hill's Annual Golf Outing Scores Nearly \$100K for Local Charities*

LANCASTER, PA, April, 2017—Turkey Hill Minit Markets recently hit a hole-in-one within the community, when the company donated more than \$90,000 to 11 local charities. The checks were presented during a fun-filled ceremony at the Turkey Hill corporate office in Lancaster.
