

ALL THAT CERTAIN lot of ground with the improvements thereon erected situate on the west side of North Second Street, between Alley H and Walnut Street, is the Borough of Columbia, County of Lancaster and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows in accordance with a survey made by Henry F.
